Scholarships will be offered on Wednesday 11 June 2025 and acceptance is required by Friday 13 June 2025.

Middle Years Academic Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 30% reduction in the annual tuition fee for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 5 in the 2026 school year.

Senior Years Academic Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 50% reduction in the annual tuition fee for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 7 in the 2026 school year.

All-Rounder Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 50% reduction in the annual tuition fee for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 6 or Year 7 in the 2026 school year.

Music Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 50% in the annual tuition fee reduction for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 6 or Year 7 in the 2026 school year.

Performing Arts Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 50% in the annual tuition fee reduction for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 6 or Year 7 in the 2026 school year.

Sports Scholarship

Value of the scholarship is up to 50% in the annual tuition fee reduction for consecutive years until they complete Year 8. Applicants must be entering Year 6 or Year 7 in the 2026 school year.
